

# Bantry Sewerage Scheme Newsletter



**Bantry Sewerage Scheme** is a project being co-financed by Cork County Council and the Department of the Environment, Heritage, & Local Government (DEHLG).

This project is on the DEHLG's Water Services Investment Programme as a project to commence construction. The procurement of this major infra-structural project has been divided into two separate contracts which are programmed to run simultaneously.

**Contract 1:**

Civil Engineering Contract. This contract is being undertaken by Murnane & O'Shea Building Contractors.

**Contract 2:**

Mechanical & Electrical contract. This contract is being undertaken by Response Engineering Ltd.

The total construction cost for the two contracts is estimated at close to €7 million.

## Construction Underway

Issue 1—September 2008

Construction works on the Bantry Wastewater Treatment Plant is underway and contracts have been signed for Contract 1 (Civil Engineering Contract) and Contract 2 (Mechanical & Electrical Contract). Construction started earlier this year and is programmed to be ongoing for approximately 18 months.

The project is being managed by Mott MacDonald Pettit Consulting Engineers and by Cork County Council's Water Services Investment Programme Project Team under the direction of Mr. Noel O'Keeffe, County Engineer.

The project involves the construction of a Wastewater Treatment Facility capable of treating effluent from a population of 6,000 people. The project also involves the upgrading of the pumping stations located adjacent to Wolfetone Square and the construction of approximately 3 km of pipework.

While the construction works will bring some disruption and delay to traffic, the preparation of detailed Traffic Management Plans will help keep this disruption to a minimum.

Cork County Council will liaise with all stakeholders involved to ensure that any potential disruptions are flagged at an early stage and mitigation strategies are put in place.

### PROJECT PROGRAMME:

The Wastewater Treatment Plant site has been cleared and the contractor has begun the construction of the treatment tanks. Construction of the rising main from the pumping station at Wolfetone Square to the Wastewater Treatment Plant has also begun. The Waste Water Treatment Plant, Pumping Station, Pipelines and Associated Works are expected to be complete by mid 2009.
